The visitor map shows key Melbourne landmarks, attractions and public transport for the inner city area including train stations, tram routes and the Free Tram Zone.

The conference venue, Pullman Melbourne on the Park, is located just off the eastern edge of the map at Wellington Parade (Map Ref H4), next to Fitzroy Gardens, a few minutes' walk from the Free Tram Zone. Frequent trams head directly into the Melbourne City Centre along Wellington Parade — Tram No.75 via Flinders Street and Tram No.48 via Collins Street.




